





Welded & Woven Wire Mesh


We know each type of mesh construction serves a specific purpose. Our high-quality products ensure the demands of your project are met.

There are two ways in which wire mesh is typically manufactured:



Welded

Welded mesh wire is created by resistance-welding. This process allows for strong, consistent welds without filler metal in the joints.



Woven

Woven wire mesh is made much like fabric, as it is woven on looms. Wires are woven together to create wire mesh in different patterns, such as plain weave and twilled weave.

Weave Types



It's important to note that your choice of metal will contribute to a weave's strength and longevity.



Hexagonal

Hex mesh is twisted steel wire mesh with hexagonal openings. It is also referred to as chicken wire, as it is often used as fencing and to build chicken coops.



Plain weave

Plain weave wire mesh can be used for sifting and particle separation as well as pest control.




Intercrimp weave

Intercrimp weave is used in trellises as well as outdoor lighting designs.

Surface & Finish Coatings




Surface and finish coatings are another facet of wire mesh manufacturing that affect the appearance and functionality of the product.




Mill Finish

Mill finish refers to the surface finish of mesh after it is manufactured. The texture is usually rough, but some mill finished mesh is also polished, smooth, and uniform.



Poly Coated

Mesh polyester is resistant to solvents, high temperatures, water and chemicals.



Galvanized

Galvanized mesh can be woven or welded from steel wire. It is then immersed in molten zinc. It is also referred to as galvanized screen wire and galvanized hardware cloth.
